## **Product description**

In addition to beautiful multicolored natural and gray tones, there are also easily combinable tones such as cornflower, berry, lime and aqua. With 100,000 abrasion cycles, it is particularly robust and therefore perfect for use in the hotel & restaurant sector. Its acoustic values are also impressive. Due to its colorfulness and wool character, Finn corresponds perfectly with the Manchester wool item.
